ARTSCIENCE LATE

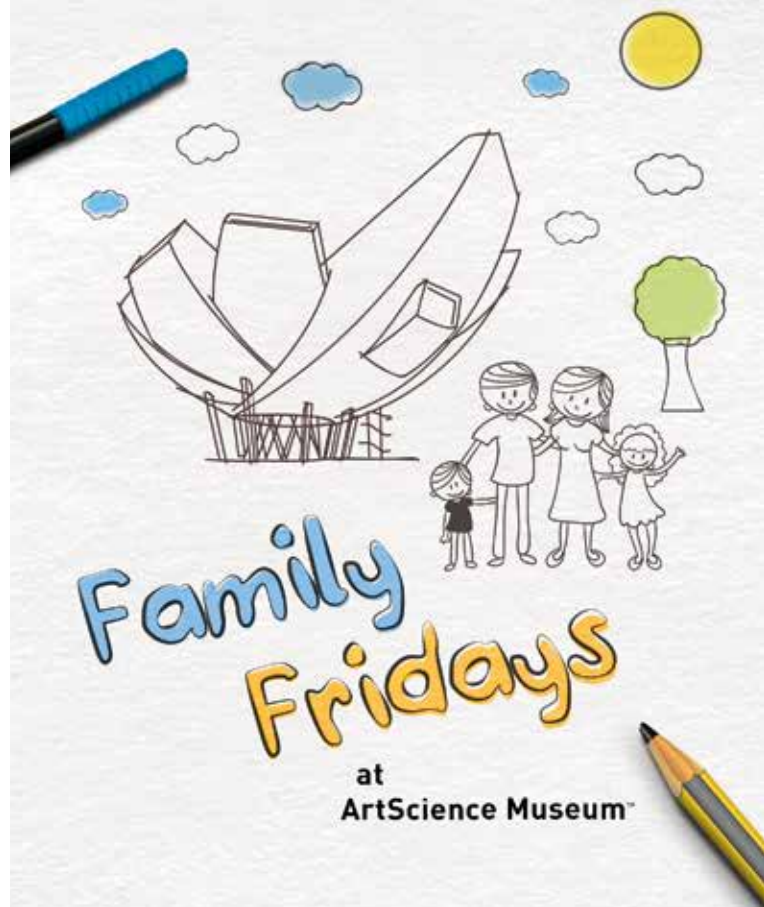
Thursday - 21 Sep & 19 Oct | 7pm - 10pm
