



Marina Bay Sands holds inaugural three-day Virtual Career Fair

Integrated resort amplifies recruitment efforts for its biggest job fair this year with more than 1,000 positions for hire

Singapore (30 November 2021) – Marina Bay Sands is set to hold its first-ever Virtual Career Fair from 6 to 8 December 2021, with over 1,000 positions available across the Integrated Resort (IR) for hire. Leveraging on the IR's recently launched [Virtual Meeting Place](#), the three-day event aims to engage potential jobseekers via unique features of the virtual platform, such as live chat functions with job recruiters and interactive features to view information about available jobs.

Major hiring departments including Food & Beverage, Hotel Operations, Corporate, Casino Operations, Mall Management, Museum, Facilities and Security Service, will set up dedicated e-booths and meeting spaces across all three days for attendees to explore available roles and internship opportunities. Participants will also enjoy access to a content library of videos, images

and e-brochures which will give them a glimpse into the vibrant work culture and growth opportunities at Marina Bay Sands.

“The Covid-19 pandemic has certainly sparked new ways of recruiting and hiring. The Virtual Career Fair comes on the heels of Marina Bay Sands’ newly appointed security apprentice [Grow and Protect Programme](#), designed to identify and train suitable candidates

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keen to develop a professional career in the field of Security. In addition to a sign-on bonus¹, successful applicants will learn while they earn over a year-long programme, and attain their Police Licensing and Regulatory Department (PLRD) license as they build their experience and confidence.

Hiring in the Food & Beverage department is also ramping up ahead of new dining concepts in the pipeline, including the highly anticipated Wakuda Singapore's opening in early 2022. The IR is also currently extending a [sign-on bonus](#) for successful F&B candidates to receive an additional one month's base salary² when they apply now till 31 December 2021.

To provide jobseekers with never-seen-before footage behind the highly dynamic F&B operations at the iconic landmark, Marina Bay Sands has also produced a video series titled '[The Hiring Never Stops](#)' which debuted in August 2021. Hosted by local personality Jamie Yeo, the series of short, impactful videos sees Yeo traversing the F&B world led by diverse culinary and service personalities, with an aim of attracting talent to join and shape the future of hospitality.
