Zhang Ziyi and Wang Lee Hom to attend Gala Premiere of “My Lucky Star”

*Marina Bay Sands’ MasterCard Theatres becomes the

Singapore (9 September, 2013) – Marina Bay Sands is set to welcome its fifth movie premiere at the MasterCard Theatres with the highly-anticipated “My Lucky Star”, a Chinese-US romantic-comedy starring renowned movie stars Zhang Ziyi and Wang LeeHom. Directed by the acclaimed Dennie Gordon and co-produced by Zhang, the movie premiere will take place at the MasterCard Theatres at Marina Bay Sands on 13 September.

The Chinese-US crossover movie production was filmed at Marina Bay Sands in Singapore – a hot spot for international movies and documentaries since it opened in April 2010. Scenes were shot at the iconic Sands SkyPark, Observation Deck and hotel lobby.

Winning a trip to Singapore catapults her life in a new direction, as she meets the man of her dreams – David (played by Wang) – the handsome super-spy from her own comics.

Apart from Singapore, *My Lucky Star* crew also filmed at other major cities, from Sophie's stomping grounds in Beijing, to outback fishing villages of Hong Kong, and the gondolas of The Venetian Macao's canals in Macao.

The star-studded romantic-comedy will join in the rungs of four other international gala premieres that have been held at the MasterCard Theatres at Marina Bay Sands this year—including "The Grandmaster" held in January, Japanese movie "The After-Dinner Mysteries (Nazotoki wa Dinner no Ato de)" and homegrown director Anthony Chen's "Ilo Ilo", which won the coveted Camera d'Or award for best feature film at the Cannes Festival and Korean blockbuster "Cold Eyes" which premiered less than a week ago.

Transportation

The nearest **taxi** drop-off and pick-up point is at the Casino entrance, which is a 5-minute walk to the Skating Rink at The Shoppes.

Visitors can also choose to arrive in style via a **water taxi** from Singapore River Cruise or Singapore River Explorer with docks located along popular destinations like Merlion, Esplanade, Promenade, Clifford Pier, Clarke Quay and Boat Quay.

Carpark lots at Marina Bay Sands are limited during peak hours. The self-drive lots are accessible via the South Entrance located at Sands Expo and Convention Centre, the North Entrance accessible via Bayfront Avenue theatres and Hotel Tower 3. At Hotel Tower 1, as well as the Casino, only valet parking is available.

Alternatively, drivers can park at Wilson Carpark located on Bayfront Avenue. Drivers can park their vehicle and walk over to The Shoppes at Marina Bay Sands which is 10 minutes away.
